General Refund Policy

To be eligible for a refund, learner must notify the Division of Extended Education of their intent to drop course enrollment(s) 2 business days prior to the course start date. Full refund will be provided, minus any administration fees and non-refundable deposits.

For certificate programs with multiple course start dates within the term, notification for all course drops/withdrawals must be received 2 business days prior to the start of term (start of term is deemed to be the initial course start date).

Full refund will be provided, minus any administration fees and non-refundable deposits.

Summer Camps & Series Summer Arts School Refund Policy

Requests received more than 2 weeks prior to the workshop/camp start date are eligible for a full refund, less a \$50 administration fee. If Red Deer Polytechnic cancels a workshop or camp, you will receive a full refund for your workshop/camp fees. If you need to withdraw from a workshop less than two weeks before the start date, you are not eligible for a refund.

Withdrawal Policy

Withdrawal after the course drop date will result in a “WD” or “Incomplete” on learner transcript.

Cancellation Policy

Red Deer Polytechnic, Division of Extended Education, reserves the right to cancel courses due to insufficient enrolment. In the event a course is cancelled, the learner will be notified and given the option to be transferred to an alternate course offering. If the alternate enrolment is declined, or response is not received within 5 business days, a full refund will be processed. (Note: refund processing times may take up to 6 weeks)
