Peter Loebel is a visual artist whose inspirations are the human figure and plein-air subjects. He works with charcoal, ink and watercolour and develops his compositions from a quick gestural drawing done on site. Each representation attempts to break the static condition of the subject, revealing a vibrant movement and creating a transitional snapshot.

Peter was born in Munich, Germany and moved to Canada in 2001. He has a background in engineering and in 2010 finished his MA in Architecture. His fascination with figure drawing roots back to 2001 when he joined Basic Inquiry, a life drawing studio in Vancouver, and later joined the board. He is now working in Victoria and is associated with a variety of local plein-air art groups. Amongst others, Peter has been given workshops in Urban Sketching at the Metchosin International Summer School of Arts and for the Pender Island Artist Society. He is currently teaching at the Cedar Hill Recreation Centre in Victoria.
