Doyle teaches fused glass and glass bead-making classes at the Vernon Community Art Centre. She also hosts and produces a cable TV show with Shaw called Artisan's Alley that showcases notable artists and artisans from the North Okanagan.

While she does a limited number of shows and sales throughout the year, her work is available for purchase in a number of stores and gallery shops in Western Canada.
