He is a professional engineer who discovered his love of working with precious metals almost 30 years ago, while taking an introduction to jewellery class at the Alberta College of Art and Design. He is one of only a handful of metal artists in North America whose primary focus is the design and fabrication of filigree objects. Milt has ancient been fine tunina fabrication techniques in his filiaree Calgary Alberta studio, creating a body of contemporary silver and gold filigree

jewellery and other filigree objects. Milt has been passing on his knowledge of filigree techniques through in person and online workshops, lectures and instructional videos. He is a professional member of the Alberta Craft Council and a member of the Calgary Rock and Lapidary Club. Milt has created a series of 8 instructional videos demonstrating basic filigree techniques, for Ganoksin, the world's largest online community of metalsmiths. His works have been published in Edmonton's Where Magazine, Alberta Craft Magazine and in Victoria Lansford's 2019 Update of her Russian Filigree DVD.
