### **Required Supplies:**

Students who do not wish to purchase these Items, can borrow them from the instructor

- Flush Cutter - Xuron Maxi Shear Flush Cutter or Similar Rio # 111273 (Under \$20)
- Chain Nosed Pliers - Simple Low Cost – Rio # 111911 or similar (Under \$15)
- Steel Bench Block - 4” x 4” or similar
- Digital Caliper - 4 “ Metal Caliper similar to Canadian Tire Product #058-6800-4
- Soldering Block - Ceramic Honeycomb about 5.5” x 4” – Similar to Rio #: 502005
- Soldering Tweezers - AA or MM Profile (not cross lock) Should cost less than \$5
- Magnification - Only if you regularly use one ie Optivisor

### **Notes To Students**

1. Series has an assortment of hand tools available for your use, but feel free to bring your favorite pliers, files, flex shaft polishing tools, ring and bezel mandrels, bezel pusher, burnisher etc
2. If you do not wish to purchase the above tools, then you can borrow from the instructor, but you will have to share borrowed tools with the instructor and other students.
3. Fine Silver Wire, Sterling Silver wire, stones, etc will be provided in your Student Material Kits. No need for you to bring any. Additional silver will be available from the instructor if required
